Summary of Burtle Parish Council Meeting – May 2024

This was the annual meeting of the Parish Council Cllr R Dallimore was re-elected as Chairman and Cllr S Bull was re-elected as Vice chairman for the coming year. Cllr N Ponsillo will continue as Footpath Liaison Officer.

Planning

Amended plans for change of use of agricultural land to domestic curtilage at Cherry Tree Barn, Robins Lane, Burtle were considered and Cllrs unanimously agreed to continue to support the application.

Occupation of the dwelling known as 'Greystones' in non-compliance of the joint agricultural occupancy condition applied as condition 3 of planning permission 55/01/0008 at Greystones, Burtle Road. After discussion Cllrs unanimously agreed to support the application as they can see no reasons for the agricultural tie to remain.

Finance

Audit 2023-24 Accounts for 2023-24 were agreed. Papers must be submitted to the external auditor by end of June.

Grant to Burtle Church Cllrs agreed a grant of £500 for this current year towards the upkeep of the churchyard.

Official portrait of King Charles 111. Cllrs have applied for and received a free framed portrait of the king and they hope that the Burtle Village Hall Committee will find space to hang it in the village hall.
