55/24/00005 Application to reduce spread of 3No. Horse Chestnuts (within TPO Ref Group G1) on western side by 1.5m at Merlouin, Mark Road, Burtle.

After discussion Councillors unanimously agreed to support the application with the following comments:

1 Photographs supplied with the application appear to show that the building being constructed is very near to the protected trees. Councillors would like confirmation that the building is in the position agreed in application 55/19/00001 and that all measures set out in item 2 of the permission granted ie position of the building, Tree Protection Plan and Method Statement and the submitted and approved Tree Protection Plan (Blackledge Design) have been complied with.

2 Councillors position remains the same as in previous applications on this site in that any work agreed will not be detrimental to the health of these mature protected trees which are a feature on the entrance to the village.

41 TRAFFIC THROUGH THE VILLAGE AND ROAD MARKINGS

Towans Lorries Travelling Through Burtle - Somerset Highways Traffic Management are unable to take any actions regarding the number or size of lorries passing through the village. No response has been received from Somerset Planning. Other enquiries suggest that Towans are visiting more than one site in the area. Clerk has liaised with Meare Clerk and residents in Meare and Westhay are experiencing a nuisance with Towans lorries travelling from Ashcott to Meare, Oxenpill, Westhay to Shapwick. It is believed that they may also be taking peat from Godwin's to reinstate land involved in the installations of the new pylons. Burtle Parish Council will continue to pursue the matter and liaise with adjacent Parish Councils.

SID has recently been situated by Southview Farm. Some high speeds were recorded but data shows that 70% of vehicles adhering to the speed limit.

Additional bracket has been ordered for SID. There will then be one for each post making it easier when location of device is changed.
