

Summary of Burtle Parish Council Meeting – November 2024

Highways

Blocked gullies clerk to check whether these have been cleared.

Road signs 30mph sign by First and Last is leaning and faded uneven surface sign in Edington Road to be reported to Highways dept.

Hedge at the Nydon, Edington Road has become overgrown making the road narrower. As this is in Edington parish a request to be made to Edington PC to arrange for this to be cut back.

Planning

55/24/00008 Erection of a single storey detached building to provide ancillary accommodation at Burtle Moor Farm, Burtle Road, Burtle. After discussion Councillors unanimously agreed that they have no objections to the application as it is on the site of an existing building. However, they note that footpaths BW14/23 and BW14/22 run through Burtle Moor Farm and would like confirmation that the footpaths have been taken into consideration.

55/24/00007 Erection of 1no. dwelling and detached garage on site of 1no. existing dwelling and outbuilding (to be demolished), and associated works at Little Acre/Lester, Catcott Broad Drove, Burtle. Somerset - North Planning Department has refused permission. Councillors were disappointed at this decision as although it is not technically within the builtup area of the village it is adjacent to the last property within the builtup area and they feel that it would have tidied up the plot.

Road Closure by Burtle Inn

Somerset Council has promised to keep the parish informed of when the next attempt to install the temporary building at the rear of Huntspill House will take place. They have also advised that repairs to the damage caused to the pavement during the last attempt are in hand.

Poppies in Burtle Councillors offered a vote of thanks to Barbara Vowles for organising the poppy collection in the village and the display of large poppies on the Sandpit and churchyard.
