79 PLANNING Applications **55/24/00008** Erection of a single storey detached building to provide ancillary accommodation at Burtle Moor Farm, Burtle Road, Burtle, TA7 8NH

However, they note that footpaths BW14/23 and BW14/22 run through Burtle Moor Farm and would like confirmation that the footpaths have been taken into consideration.

Permission refused by Somerset Planning - North

Councillors were very disappointed with this decision as, although it is not technically within the built-up area of the village, it is adjacent to the last property within the built-up area and they feel that it would have tidied up the plot. Although there has been no conventional residential building on the site, a couple had lived on the site for over twenty years. It is felt that this refusal will leave the plot open to be used for unauthorized siting of caravans etc in the same way as land further along Catcott Broad Drove.
